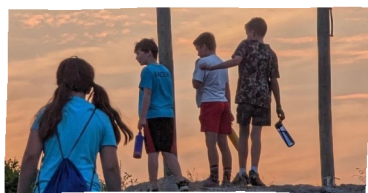

MISSIONS: WHEREVER GOD PLACES US- HERE, NEAR, FAR



Near:

Tulsa- Our team served in Tulsa with Mobile Missions. We had many service opportunities that were relational and compassionate. Backyard bible clubs included games, songs, testimonies, Bible lessons, and an opportunity to serve them lunch while developing bonds of friendship. A block party was a fun outreach for the community. Service opportunities also included Cross walking, which consisted of carrying a large cross around the neighborhood near the church in Tulsa, mowing an elderly woman's lawn, helping another woman move, and feeding the hungry.

Here:
We have been actively sharing the love and good news of the gospel in our own city. Bibles for Texas: Nancy Bird gathered Bibles for flood victims in Texas who lost all their personal possessions, or were otherwise, traumatically affected by the flood. Nancy delivered them with Donna Kaye, Saturday, August 16, 2025. Vacation Bible School was put on for our own children and our neighborhood children. Food Distribution took place as we provided food to various local food pantries, downtown area needs, and for the Tulsa outreach. The OnMission team involved our teens reaching out to the lost at Scissortail Park in the Malls, all in our own downtown OKC.

Oregon - With GoStudents, an Oklahoma Baptist organization, our team put the Armor of God on daily before actively serving in Oregon during the mission trip. Conducting Vacation Bible School provided many opportunities for loving one-on-one interactions and conversations about God. From service opportunities such as weeding garden beds, to free-lance unplanned conversations, we spread God's love and the Gospel. Thank you church for supplying the means for this mission endeavor, that gave the team a glimpse of a life-long commitment to mission work.



Update From Oklahoma Baptists: 8 weeks of camp at Falls Creek and 12 sessions at CrossTimbers have come to a close. Over 55,000 participated in these camps and 2,523 children and students committed their lives to follow Christ in faith. 514 Students sensed God's call to vocational ministry.

Throughout the night last night, running through my mind was my new favorite song of Zach Williams, Jesus Loves:

Come on in, the door is open
And the Savior's arms are too
The table's set, a seat is waiting
And He saved it just for you
So no more running
No more hiding
Come on in and you will find
That you don't have to be enough
To be someone Jesus loves...
No, no, no,
It's been decided by the blood
Yes, you're someone Jesus loves

In Luke 14, Jesus tells a parable about a banquet God has prepared in the Kingdom of God: The ones invited had excuses why they couldn't come, so the host sent out a servant to gather the poor, crippled, blind, and lame from the streets and alley ways of the city, but there was still room, so he sends the servant out again.
