Another reason February is a great month is that we will begin a new sermon series through the Gospel of John on the 1st. I have titled this series "That You May Believe". This is, of course, a direct quote from John's Gospel in a few locations and the purpose for which he wrote the book.

**John 20:30-31**, "Jesus

performed many other signs in the presence of his disciples that are not written in this book. But these are written so that you may believe that Jesus is the Messiah, the Son of God, and that by believing you may have life in his name."

I'm looking forward to this series for many reasons, but the main one is the rich theological truths found in the Gospel. Just a quick look at the brief outline below will help you understand the direction John takes his readers. Unlike the Synoptic Gospels, John is not as concerned with the progression of events as we might expect in other historical writings. John's true focus was on revealing who Jesus is. That focus makes this a timeless book, one that will give

us great understanding today.

**The Revelation of Incarnation (John 1)**

**The Demonstration of Incarnation (John 2-12) - we will study the 7 Signs of Jesus**

**The Intimacy of Incarnation (John 13-17) - Jesus'**

**connection and preparation with the disciples**

**The Victory of Incarnation (John 18-21) - He was dead, but He is alive!**

I challenge you to read and reread the Gospel of John. Come prepared each Sunday to find the truths of who Jesus is, and then let those truths transform your life. Make it a great February! I know I intend to.

# Dear Miss Verity:

**Dear Miss Verity,**  
**Hello, my name is Brenda and I am a college student. My professor said the Bible is an unreliable document which has been changed many times over the years. He said it is full of fables. Is that true?**



Dear Brenda,

Sadly, many college students have encountered this false narrative and accepted it with nothing to support it. Here are a few reasons to reject this uninformed view of the Bible:

- The Bible is 66 distinct books
- The books were authored by 40 different authors over 1,600 years
- The writers lived on 3 different continents and spoke in 3 different languages
- The message from book to book carries the same theme of God's love for mankind

Let's talk about the Bible being changed making it unreliable. As you will see the facts tell us the Bible is the most accurate ancient document on the planet. Let's compare it to other ancient writings:

- Plato's Republic written 400 BCE
- o Earliest copy we have is from 900 CE. (1,300-year gap)
- o We only have 7 copies. (0% accuracy)
- Julius Caesar's Galic Wars – Written 100 BCE
- o Earliest copy is from 900 CE (1,000-year gap)
- o We only have 10 copies (0% accuracy)
- Homer's Lliad written 800 BCE
- o Earliest copy 400 BCE (400-year gap)
- o 643 copies (95% accuracy)
- New Testament written between 50-100 CE
- o Earliest copy 125 CE (25-year gap)
- o 24,000 + copies (99.5% accuracy)

This is only the tip of the iceberg for the concrete evidence proving the reliability of the Bible. We have not discussed the many fulfilled prophecies, the archaeological evidence, or the historical evidence from secular historians. You can trust the Bible with your life!

"He restores my soul"...and who more than Jesus knows how to do that? Because Jesus became a man and dwelt among us, He knows what we go through on a daily basis. Our circumstances, our bad choices, our physical aches and pains, but most of all our broken hearts, He knows how to heal them all...He leads us into rest in green pastures and beside quiet waters.

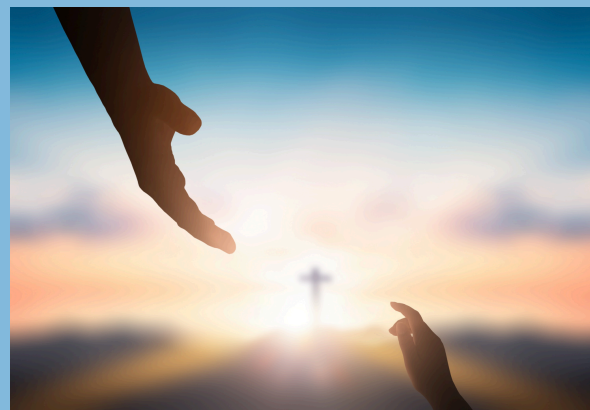
To me, a green pasture is an open field of soft green grass, clover, wildflowers sprinkled about, but, most of all, a calming peaceful place. During the day, it's a place of warmth and sunshine. In the evening, it's covered by a cool, crisp breeze as the sun goes down. An open field so large predators are reluctant to approach for lack of cover. And with quiet waters nearby lending their soothing sounds to the air, who could not be calmed in such an environment? Who would not feel safe there knowing the Good Shepherd is standing watch over the field?

Follow Jesus to the green pasture He has prepared for you! When family or friends betray you, use you, and walk away from you, follow Jesus to the pasture. When divorce, death, finances or health issues overwhelm you, follow Jesus to the pasture He has prepared just for you and rest. Trust Him to keep watch over you through the dark night. Remember, he knows what it's like to be betrayed, beaten beyond recognition, lied to, lied about, left alone in pain, and have His Father turn His back on Him. Yet, He overcame it all!! When Jesus rose from the grave, man's words and actions were of no consequence. He was fully restored...better than before!! He can do the same with you and your painful situation if you fully rest in Him. Remember, it doesn't matter what people say or do to us, how we look, how rich or poor we are, how many children we have or don't have, how many degrees we have or don't have...it only matters that we get to sit at Jesus's table when He calls us home. Seek Him with your whole heart. Obey His Word. Then, trust Him through the night and let His peace restore you.

Our church has been asked to serve a mission cause. Inlow Baptist Camp, about 60 miles outside of Albuquerque, NM needs our help. This is a camp I have been personally involved with since 1950, as a 10 yr old camper, and later as counselor, camp missionary, and longtime volunteer.

**CALL TO ACTION:** Therefore, May 10-16, 2026 Surrey Hills BC will begin a new annual mission endeavor. We are looking for men and women also if they desire, to spend a week working to help get ready for the camping season and to do general work.

**GETTING THERE:** We will leave SHBC after worship on May 10 and drive 8 hours to camp. I suggest you bring a sack lunch and then we will probably stop for a fast-food supper. Our team will be staying at the camp and eating at the camp.

**COMING HOME :** We will return home on Saturday, May 16.

**COST** will only be \$150:

- \$50 for camp food

- \$25 for auto gas

- \$20 for food while traveling & a Mexican dinner on Friday evening in Albuquerque.

**WHAT TO BRING :** We do not have to take any of our own tools as the camp will have everything we need.

**WHERE TO STAY:** We will each be provided with an \*individual private room w a full bed\* at the Elliott Lodge, and the camp provides bedding and towels, and wash rags.

The camp is located in the beautiful Manzano Mountains southeast of ABQ, and it will still be cold at night and comfortable during the day. The camp elevation is 7,750 feet.

**WHAT WE'LL DO:** Many men don't want to be involved in the other church missions endeavors, but this is something you can put your hands on, right up your alley. We will be doing hands on stuff (building, tearing down, cleaning up, working with wood, in the dirt, etc.) and we can use men of all trades. The camp manager's name is Clay Pope. He is a deacon, contractor, and a very knowledgeable man and you will love working with him.

This will be a time we, as men, can fellowship and get to know each other. I believe it will make us stronger as church members and Christians. Wives can go also. I can guarantee that if you go for the first time, you will want to go back year after year. You will see an abundance of deer, maybe a bear, and maybe a mountain lion. But don't worry they don't eat Baptists. LOL

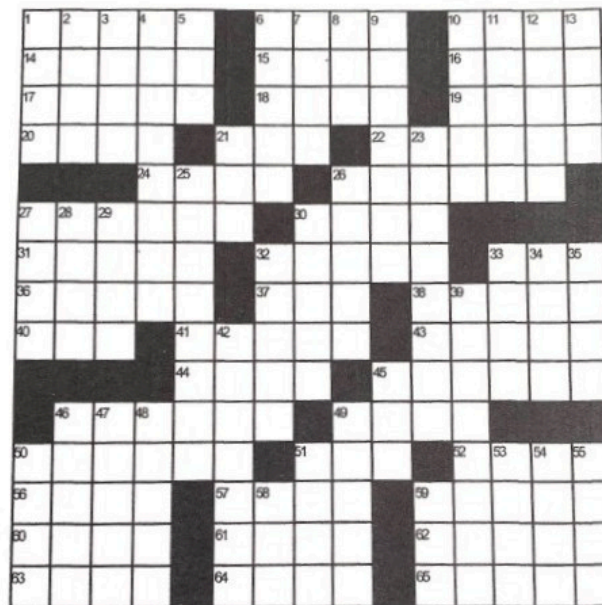

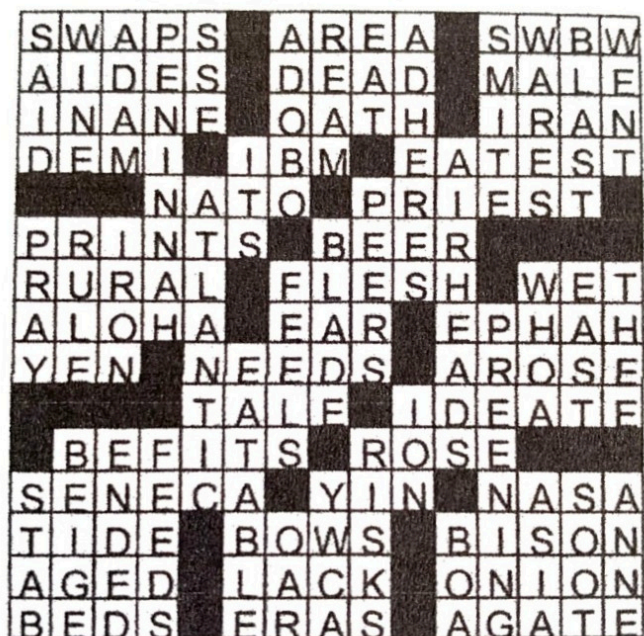
